• WHAT TO DO?

Individual participants will create projects. These projects may include:lesson plans with at least two practical examples OR recordings of open lessons based on one of the above-mentioned topics (up to 1 hour) OR a mini course (for a duration of up to three hours) OR educational interactive videos OR other relevant learning materials.

WHAT ARE THE AWARDS?

The top individual in each category (totally 4 winners) and 1 individual (Peer Choice Award) will go on a 5-day study tour to China, visiting Chinese university, such as Beijing Normal University and NetDragon Digital Education Town.

The specific arrangement is subject to the itinerary after the selection and in case if the individual refuses a study tour trip, no requests for monetary compensation will be entertained.
